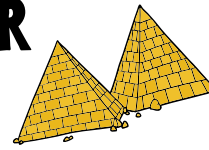


A STUDENTS GUIDE TO THE NILE RIVER

Made up of the Blue Nile and the White Nile.

The word Nile comes from the Greek word Neilos which means river valley.

MORE:

It has length of 6695km.

The source is from Burundi Mountains, Africa and flows northwards into the Mediterranean Sea.

The 4 countries of Africa it flows through are Burundi, Sudan, Ethiopia, and Egypt.



DO YOU KNOW?

Herodotus, a Greek historian called Egypt, "The gift of Nile".

TAKE NOTE:

The river brings black soil down from the mountains and deposits them on the banks of the river.

Sometimes it overflows and causes destruction.

Other times, it has too little water which means that people could not grow plants.
